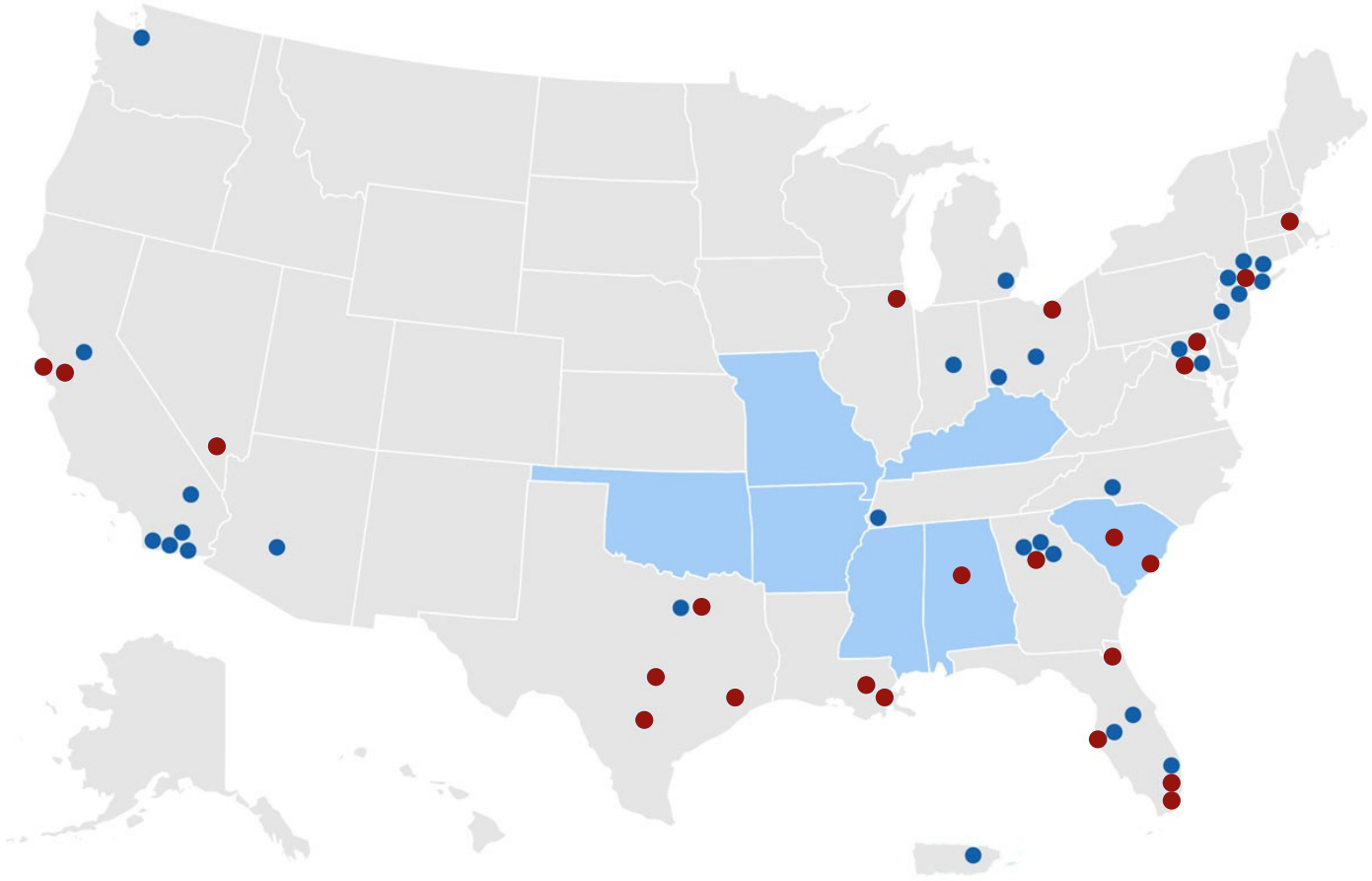
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Ending the HIV Epidemic in the U.S. (EHE)

One in Five People with HIV is Housing Insecure



- Over 1 in 5 (21%) of all PWH surveyed nationally reported at least one experience of homelessness or housing instability in the past 12 months, of whom almost half (44%) had at least one experience of literal homelessness.¹
- Compared to stably housed PWH, those experiencing housing instability experienced the same significantly worse HIV health care engagement and outcomes as those experiencing literal homelessness.¹

Jurisdictional Challenges

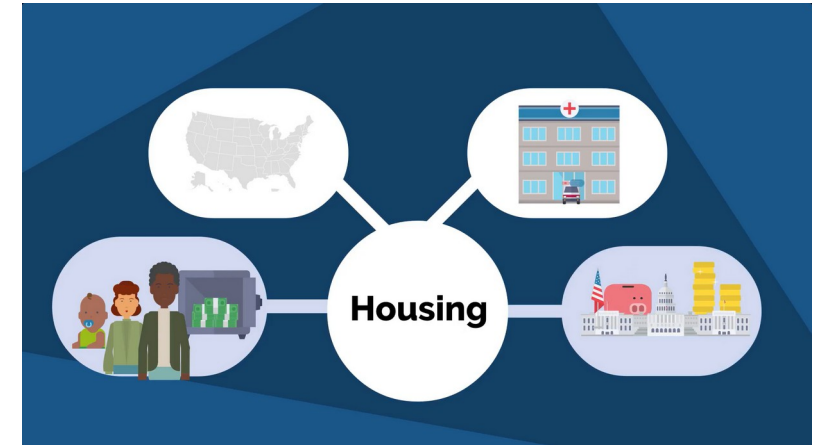
- Lack of buy-in and investment for housing and housing support services for PWH, despite robust evidence demonstrating the need for and impact of these services
- Ensuring housing and housing support services reach marginalized populations with the greatest needs

HIV housing assistance is a strong predictor of improved health outcomes, including retention in care and viral load suppression.²

- Provides an overview of evidence-based best practices jurisdictions can support to address barriers to housing for PWH



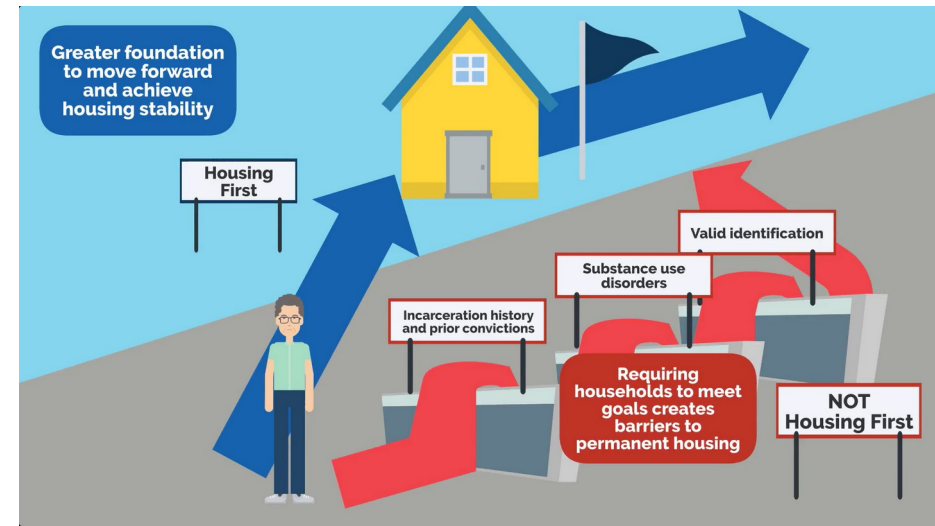
